

STAFF TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

SUMMER 2009

This is your guide to the restrictions on the use of free and privilege staff travel facilities. Please bear the following notes in mind when planning your journey as these will assist you in getting the best out of your concessions.

- Trains shown in the passenger timetable with U or S stops cannot be used for either alighting or joining at the stations designated.
- If a booking system is in operation buy your privilege tickets in advance before boarding the train. Failure to do so will mean you will be charged the standard single fare for the journey as you will not be able to purchase a privilege ticket on the train.
- If you wish to use a sleeper service, book as early as possible. Only a limited number of reservations may be available for staff travel on each service and this can sometimes be reduced if demand is high.
- If you wish to travel on a train marked with the symbol **R** in the passenger timetable you must obtain a seat reservation. This will be issued free of charge to ticket holders. On those services designated **R** seat reservations are strongly recommended (a fee, where applicable, will be payable).

CrossCountry Trains

There are no restrictions to users of free and privilege travel facilities on any CrossCountry Trains service, however, the following should be noted:

- (i) Active staff holders of National Rail First Class travel facilities must give priority to fare-paying First Class customers.
- (ii) Active staff holders of National Rail Standard travel facilities are requested to vacate their seats if fare-paying customers are standing.

PLEASE NOTE:

Whilst there are no specified restrictions on CrossCountry Trains services as outlined above. Due to high demand and limited capacity in 1st class accommodation, CrossCountry Trains respectfully asks all active staff travel facilities holders using free and reduced rate 1st class travel facilities, to refrain from occupying 1st class accommodation on the following routes/services as outlined below:

Please Note

Users of First Class travel facilities should always give fare-paying First Class passengers priority on all trains. This means under no circumstances should First Class seats be booked in advance on East Midlands Trains services. This ruling does not apply to retired staff.

First class travel facility holders are requested to respectfully refrain from accepting the complimentary glass of wine and light snacks but are welcome to accept tea, coffee, mineral water and fruit juice.

First class lounges are not available to any first class travel facility holders before 0900.

First Capital Connect

Holders of active First Class free travel facilities are requested to give priority to fare-paying passengers on peak services and to relinquish First Class seats if fare-paying passengers are standing. This does not apply to retired staff.

First Great Western

In respect of journeys commencing at Newbury or Reading and terminating at Paddington (and vice versa) on services which arrive at Paddington between 07.15 and 09.00 and depart from Paddington between 16.30 and 19.15 holders of all staff travel facilities should only use accommodation where spare seats are available. Whenever required by fare-paying customers, including those joining en-route, seats should be vacated immediately.

Please Note: Holders of First Class travel facilities are advised that the aforementioned does not affect the usual First Great Western requirement on all services, that is, First Class accommodation should only be used where spare seats are available. These seats should be vacated whenever required by fare paying customers. This latter ruling does not apply to retired staff.

FIRST CLASS TRAVEL

Only staff holding bona fide First Hull Trains First Class passes or ATOC Rail Staff First Class passes may occupy seats in First Class accommodation. Such staff will be expected to give up seats for fare paying passengers as may be required.

First Class pass holders are also requested not to occupy any seats until after trains have departed from London King's Cross or Hull so as to afford fare paying passengers the benefit of first choice of seats. Similarly, staff should be aware that where first class passengers may join intermediately in groups, wishing to sit together, they should be prepared to move seats so as to facilitate the customers' preferences.

First Class pass holders may partake in complimentary food and drink if offered by the on-board staff, on the understanding that the provision of this service is a discretionary privilege and priority of stock will be given to bona fide fare paying passengers.

This facility is both subject to availability and normal operating circumstances.

STANDARD CLASS TRAVEL

Staff holding bona fide First Hull Trains Standard Class passes or ATOC Rail Staff Standard Class passes may occupy seats in Standard Class accommodation only. Such staff are expected to give up seats for fare paying passengers as may be required.

Standard Class pass holders who choose to sit in First Class accommodation will be charged the First Anytime fare.

Standard Class pass holders are also requested not to occupy any seats until after trains have departed from London King's Cross or Hull so as to afford fare paying passengers the benefit of first choice of seats. Similarly, staff should be aware that where standard class passengers may join intermediately in groups, wishing to sit together, they should be prepared to move seats so as to facilitate the customers' preferences. Standard Class pass holders are not entitled to reduced/free catering provision.

National Express East Coast

FIRST AND STANDARD CLASS FACILITIES

No National Express East Coast services are currently barred to First Class travel facilities and with cooperation, this can continue. For an experimental period, there will also be no restrictions in Standard accommodation in the morning/evening Monday-Friday peaks to/from London.

1. Holders of First Class and Standard free and privilege travel facilities may use respective accommodation whenever there are seats unoccupied by fare-paying passengers. If required by fare paying passengers however, including those joining en route, staff occupying seats that have not been reserved are requested to vacate them immediately. This ruling does not apply to retired staff.
2. On all National Express East Coast trains, fare-paying passengers must be allowed to occupy their choice of seats first.
3. Active staff and dependants must not make First Class seat reservations on any National Express East Coast trains, Mondays to Fridays. Also, no Standard seat reservations can be made from Peterborough or Stevenage to London arriving London before 09.40, nor from London to Stevenage or Peterborough 16.25 - 18.05 inclusive, Mondays to Fridays.
4. Staff wishing to use dining accommodation, where provided, must approach the Customer Service Manager who will allocate any spare seats. There is no requirement to vacate these for the duration of the meal, even if the train becomes busy.

Trains starting/terminating at Glasgow, Edinburgh, Aberdeen and Inverness are exceptionally busy, especially during school holidays and whenever possible, these trains should be used only by staff who are travelling to/from stations north of Newcastle.

Southern

Southern and Gatwick Express asks you to be pro-active in considering our First and Standard Class fare paying passengers by allowing them to take their seats first. Where fare paying passengers are standing, please offer to give up your seat. This does not apply to retired staff.

FOREIGN RAILWAYS

Germany – DBag

For those entitled to travel facilities and in possession of international free coupons not endorsed with the stamp 'No supplement necessary/Duty Journey' the ICE, EC and IC trains listed below are restricted on certain dates and for certain sections of their journey. The days when restrictions apply are irrespective of whether the day concerned is a public holiday. Holders of international free coupons who travel on the barred services will be dealt with as 'Passengers not in possession of a ticket'.

Those areas of the trains designated *bahn.comfort* may only be used by passengers who participate in this loyalty scheme.

In addition we would once again like to advise you that from 9 December 2007 DB has been selling tickets abroad according to an inclusive distance-related tariff. This means that an unambiguous fare, which includes all categories of train (ICE, IC/EC and local services), applies.

Supplements previously calculated by reservation systems abroad for travel on ICE trains will no longer be charged, with the exception of those for travel on Sprinter services.

This means that:

1. for travel in ICE sprinter trains the sprinter supplement of €16/€11 is payable, together with the appropriate reservation fee. This applies for both duty and leisure journeys and is also payable by holders of International Free Passes.
2. tickets bought with International Reduced Rate Cards are valid in all categories of train; for travel in ICE sprinter trains the sprinter supplement is payable, together with the appropriate reservation fee.

Matterhorn Gotthard Railway

(formerly Brig-Visp-Zermatt, Gornergrat-Zermatt, and Furka-Oberalp Railways)

These railways in Switzerland have now been consolidated, and the facilities offered to staff are confirmed as follows:

"All Safeguarded Employees (including retired Safeguarded Employees and widow(er)s are granted half rate travel for themselves and their eligible dependents upon presentation of an International Reduced Rate Card."

Norwegian Railways - NSB

- **Myrdal – Flåm**

National and International Free Passes, and International Free Coupons, are not valid on this line.

- **Asker – Oslo Airport Gardermoen**

National and International Free Passes, and International Free Coupons, are not valid on Airport Express services on this line. FIP facilities are valid on Intercity and local services

- **Oslo – Karlstad – Stockholm**

This route has been operated by SJ since 9 January 2005.

National and International Free Passes, and International Free Coupons, are valid only between Oslo S and Charlottenberg.

- **Oslo – Göteborg**

International Free Passes and International Free Coupons are valid on this line.
